WHO SHOULD ATTEND

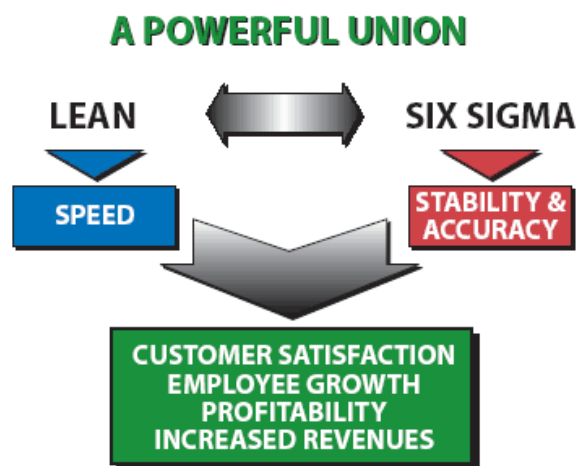
